Certified diplomas on the blockchain: Microsoft for startups selects BCDiploma

BCDiploma is one of 35 startups selected by the Île de France Region to participate in CES 2019 in Las Vegas, highlighting EMLyon business school's EdJobTech Accelerator, which is actively involved in the international deployment of the solution.
